

Your EHC Transfer Review

Hello!

We know that before your EHC Review you might have a few questions about what is happening and why. Hopefully this sheet will answer some of those questions and also help to get you and your family thinking about some of the things that might be asked.

Why is this happening?

The law has changed and Education Health and Care (EHC) Plans are now replacing Statements of Special Educational Needs.

'The purpose of an EHC Plan is to make special educational provision to meet the special educational needs of the child or young person, to secure the best possible outcomes for them across education, health and social care and, as they get older, prepare them for adulthood'. (SEND Code of Practice 9.2)

What will happen?

Your needs and aspirations will be discussed and considered at the Transfer Review meeting to help us plan appropriate outcomes and provision. An EHC Plan will be produced after the meeting and shared with you and your family. We will not just be talking about school, we will talk about things you like to do outside of school and your health too.

Who will be there?

- *You and your parent/carer*
- *Someone from your school – either a teacher or SENCO*
- *A representative from the Local Authority*
- *Other Health and Social Care professionals as appropriate*

(Think about the support you need to be able to do these things and how you like people to support you.)


