**Norfolk Park, 8<sup>th</sup> June 2019, 11.30am-4pm**

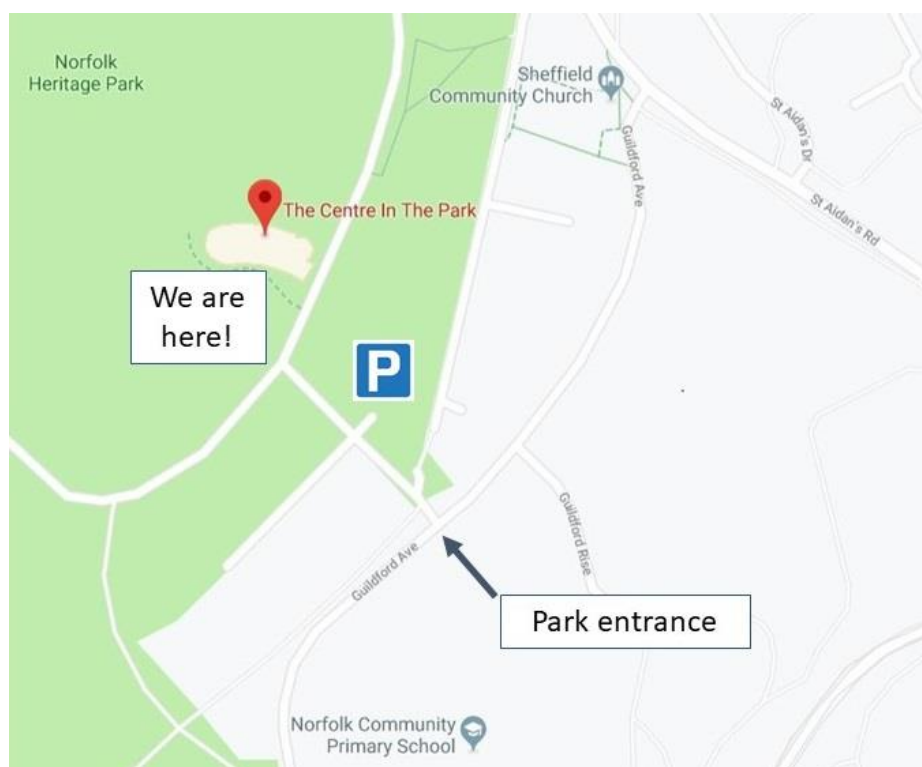
## HOW TO GET THERE

---

The event will take place at Norfolk Park, next to the Centre in the Park. The address is Guildford Avenue, Sheffield S2 2PL.

There is a small car park at the main entrance on Guildford Avenue, but that is likely to be full. There is unrestricted on-road parking on Guildford Avenue. Please use public transport if possible; the nearest tram stop is Arbourthorne Road.

## ACCESSIBILITY

---

The Centre in the Park is wheelchair accessible. There are wheelchair-accessible toilets, but no changing benches and or hoists.

The car park at the Guildford Avenue entrance has five disabled parking bays. **Please note:** As this is a public car park, **we are unable to reserve parking spaces for our guests, including Blue Badge holders.**

We will provide a **“chill-out” room** in the Centre in the Park for anyone who needs a bit of time away from the hustle and bustle.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

---

We will take photos at the event, which may be published in our newsletter, on Facebook and on our website, as well as local newspapers. Anyone NOT wishing to be photographed should wear a **fluorescent sticker** (available from the red Arts & Crafts gazebo) on their top. Please don't take photos or videos of other guests wearing these stickers!

## ENTERTAINMENT

---

You can stay for the whole event (11.30am-4pm), or just drop in for a little while. There will be a **programme of entertainment** going on for most of the event:

11.30am-1.20pm	Dance performances and improvised comedy
1.20pm-2.20pm	Free circus skills workshop: learn juggling and balloon modelling
1.20pm-3.20pm	Stilt walkers

A number of free **drop-in activities** will also be provided throughout the event, including football, arts and crafts and outdoor games.

Norfolk Park also has two recently-refurbished **playgrounds**, one for under 8s and one for over 8s. The playground for over 8s is partly wheelchair accessible and has some equipment for disabled users.

## FOOD AND DRINK

---

You can either **bring a picnic (or even a barbecue)** or **buy food** from a **pizza van** or a **burger/chips van**. We've also asked an **ice cream van** to come along.

In addition, the **Centre in the Park Café** will be open from 11am to 4pm. Telephone **0114 2860405** for more information, menus and lunchtime daily specials.

**If your child has special dietary requirements or finds waiting difficult, it would be advisable to bring your own food.**

## WHAT TO BRING

---

- A picnic, or some cash for buying food / ice cream
- Picnic blanket and/or camping chairs
- Sun screen and hats if it's sunny
- Plenty to drink

## IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER

---

If the weather is bad, we'll run a reduced number of activities in the Centre in the Park.

## HEALTH & SAFETY

---

Our risk assessment of the venue has highlighted a number of potential safety risks to children.

Norfolk Park has open access, and there will be members of the public and dogs present throughout the event. The facilities at the Centre in the Park (including toilets) will also be open to the general public throughout the event.

**In order to ensure the safety of the children, it is essential that they are supervised by a responsible adult at all times.**

**We request that you do not take dogs into the picnic area.**
