COMMUNITY STORIES is run by the University of Sheffield working with St Mary's Community Centre, Sheffield City Council, and many other local partners.

If you take part, **you will have access to a unique learning opportunity** at St Mary's and the University. Academic staff and students will work with you to tell your story in the way you want to.

At the end of the project we will stage an **exhibition** of the stories to which you can invite your family and friends.
